

VILLAGE ACCESS - SOME REASSURANCE?

Melting snow revealed that the cracks in the road and pavement next to the Wellfield development were yet wider and longer. The Parish Council has continued to press for action and information from NCC and our local County Councillor. A result of a kind, at least; Dick Phillips, Network Manager at NCC, phoned to say that one of his engineers had visually inspected the embankment and was sure that it was not in danger of immediate collapse. The Parish Council does not altogether share his



confidence, but it's their job to know these things. Now that the snow has gone, NCC will install monitoring equipment to determine exactly what

problems there are with the embankment. This will be followed by remedial work.

BUS SERVICES



During the snow the bus service sometimes turned round at the Wellfield or Hipsburn roundabouts, thus missing out the village. The problem was that no information was given about these emergency arrangements and some travellers were left waiting outside the Post Office. Arriva explained that it was left to the discretion of the individual driver and some drivers were more adventurous than others. The Parish Council is asking the bus company for a better information system in future, perhaps by getting a message to the Post Office

GREEN WASTE BINS

Many Alnmouth residents have very small gardens or yards and cannot justify the expense of a green waste bin (which are actually brown) or find room for a compost bin. Ever keen to reduce the amount of waste going to landfill via the standard bins, the Parish Council has considered getting a green waste bin for communal use. Where to locate it would be a significant problem, but if you feel you would use such a facility please let the Parish Council know.
